Peel Family Scholarship 2020

St Joseph's College Lochinvar was established by the Sisters of St Joseph in 1883. As a day and boarding school for girls in Years 7-12 up until 1993, the school maintained a strong tradition of academic excellence and inclusion, which has continued through the change (1993) to a College under the direction of the Catholic Diocese of Maitland – Newcastle. St Joseph's College is proud of its long tradition as a 'Josephite' school and maintains a strong connection to the Sisters of St Joseph.

Many families have a long association with our College; they speak highly of our Catholic Identity and the sense of community, excellent holistic education and the encouragement and support they received as students of the College. The Peel family has had three generations of girls attend St Joseph's, Lochinvar and in a spirit of generosity and support for the mission of the school, the 'Peel Family Scholarship' was established. The Scholarship is offered to honour these three generations of women and to encourage others to share in the advantages of being educated at St Joseph's College, Lochinvar.

Scholarship Detail

The scholarship will cover the payment of the tuition fee component of the St Joseph's College school fees. All other fees are to be met by the family of the applicant. A scholarship will be awarded to one student entering Year 7 in 2020 and one student entering Year 11 in 2020. Scholarships are for the 2020 academic year and do not continue into subsequent years. Current and prospective students are eligible to apply. The scholarships will continue to be offered in future years to students entering the College in Years 7 and 11.

Scholarship Criteria

Successful applicants will exhibit through appropriate documentation:

- Evidence of sustained academic achievement and consistent effort.
- Positive involvement in a range of school co-curricular activities.
- An exemplary record of behaviour and cooperation as related to school expectations.
- Qualities / values consistent with the ethos of the school.



How to Apply

Students wishing to apply for the scholarship are asked to prepare a letter addressed to the St Joseph's College Principal that addresses the criteria listed above. The letter is to be no longer than two A4 typed single sided pages using single spacing and 11 point Arial font. A scholarship application form is included with this document and must be completed and provided to the Principal with the letter of application. For Year 7 applications the student should also request that their Principal (or delegate) complete and submit the attached confidential Information Form. A copy of reports from the last two years are also to be provided at the same time, along with copies of supporting documentation in terms of awards or certificates.

Student Expectations

Students selected to receive the scholarship will be expected to:

Maintain a high level of contribution to school life whilst at St Joseph's College

Display commitment to excellence in academic life

Display consistent application and effort in school work

Have a willingness to participate in a broad range of school activities

Always show a high standard of behaviour

Be obvious in their support of the traditions and ethos of the College
