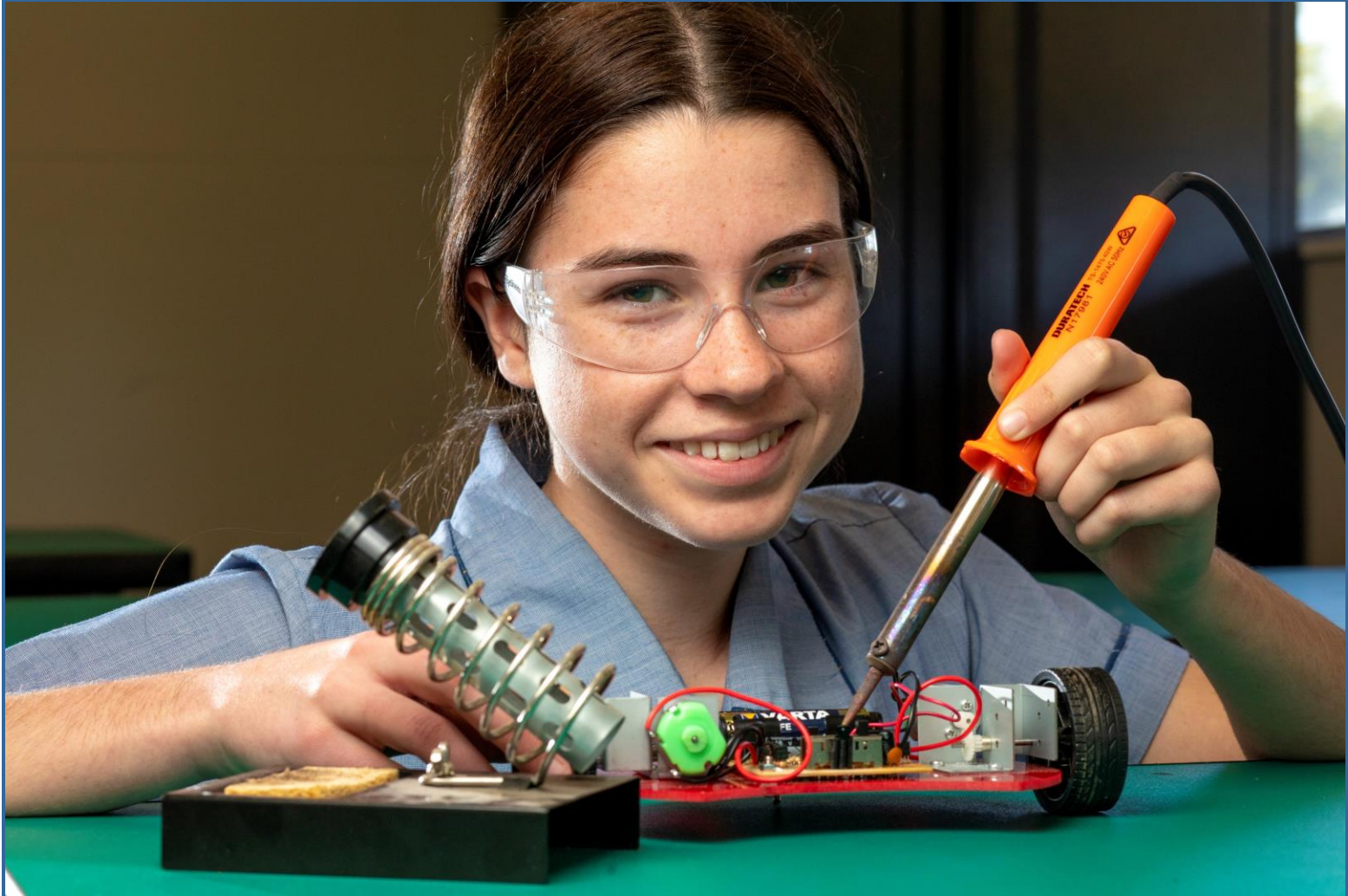




Peel Family Scholarship

St Joseph's College Lochinvar was established by the Sisters of St Joseph in 1883. As a day and boarding school for girls in Years 7-12 up until 1993 the school maintained a strong tradition of academic excellence and inclusion. From 1993, in a co-educational Years 7-10 systemic setting, the school has continued in this example. From 2018 St Joseph's College will once again be a school for students in Years 7-12 where our traditions and 'Josephite' identity continue to be deeply valued.

There are many families who have a long association with our school and who have benefited greatly from the education, encouragement and support of the College. One such example is the Peel family where three generations of Peel girls have attended St Joseph's, Lochinvar. In a spirit of generosity and support for the mission of the school, the 'Peel Family Scholarship' is offered to honour these three generations of the Peel Family and to encourage others to share in the advantage of being educated at St Joseph's College , Lochinvar.

Scholarship Detail

The scholarship will cover the payment of the tuition fee component of the St Joseph's College school fees. All other fees are to be met by the family of the applicant. A scholarship will be awarded to one student entering Year 7 in 2021 and one student entering Year 11 in 2021. **Scholarships are for the 2021 academic year and do not continue into subsequent years.** Current and prospective Year 11 students are eligible to apply. Students accepted for enrolment in Year 7 2021 are eligible to apply.

Scholarship Criteria

The following criteria are specified for the award of the scholarship. The recipient:

- Will be able to evidence a sustained level of academic effort and achievement.
- Can display positive involvement in a range of school co-curricular activities.
- Has an exemplary record of behaviour and cooperation as related to school expectations.



How to Apply

Students wishing to apply for the scholarship are asked to prepare a letter addressed to the St Joseph's College Principal which address the criteria above. The letter is to be no longer than two A4 typed single sided pages using single spacing and 12 point Arial font. A scholarship application form is included with this document and must be completed and provided to the Principal with the letter. A copy of a 2020 and 2019 school report is also to be provided, along with any copies of supporting documentation in terms of awards or certificates.

Student Expectations

Students selected to receive the scholarship will be expected to:

- Maintain a high level of contribution to school life whilst at St Joseph's College
- Display consistent application and effort in school work
- Have a willingness to participate in a broad range of school activities
- Always show a high standard of behaviour
- Be obvious in their support of the traditions and ethos of the College

If in the duration of the scholarship a student is suspended, the scholarship may be revoked.
